Ascension Choristers

The Choristers are comprised of young people in our parish in grades **3-8**. Depending upon the month, the Choristers normally sing on the first and third Sunday of each month (October – May) at the 9 a.m. Mass.

The regular practice time is on Wednesdays from 3:05-4:00 p.m.

(Students in religious education classes are released earlier as needed.)

We normally practice 3 times each month. All practices take place in church or the choir room of church. A snack is served at 3:05 p.m. before the start of each rehearsal. We also have pizza days several times throughout the season!

Later rehearsal section: Students who attend middle school in District 97 (as well as other districts) with later release times on Wednesdays are invited to join us and practice from 4:05-4:35 PM on Wednesdays. (Please contact Mr. Anderson about this later rehearsal time.)
